For purpose of consistency we recommend that you use the same format as this abstract by adopting Times New Roman (size 12) font type. After submitting, for the accepted abstract only (some abstract can be rejected) you may submit a short paper before **June 30<sup>th</sup> 2020**. The Program committee will inform whether your submission is selected for an oral or poster communication by **July 31<sup>st</sup> 2020**. **It is recommended that final papers comprise between two and six (6) A4-pages and 4 MB in a file size.** The title is in bold capital letters and centered at the top of the first page (Times New Roman (size 14) font type). It must be followed by the author(s) name(s), organization(s) (Times New Roman (size 10) font type). Leave one bank line between the title and the name of the author(s). When several authors prepare a paper, the name of the corresponding author should be underlined. The name of each one's organization should be easily distinguished. Type your abstract in no more than 700 words, followed by the keywords up to 5 words.
